The EAP is dedicated to helping the people of East Africa through the following programs:

Homes: The Partnership supports 4 homes across Kenya, sheltering nearly 300 children.

Sponsorships: Each child in our Homes is sponsored, providing for their needs.

Scholarships: The EAP supports nearly 30 needy, qualified students and promises a full education to every child in our Homes.

Medical: The Partnership operates more than 40 self-sustaining dispensaries, supports 9 hospitals, and has sent more than \$25 million in donated equipment to Kenya.

Farming & Irrigation: In partnership with local communities, the EAP provides food, jobs, and training in modern techniques, currently supporting 7 different projects.

Microfinance: By investing in people the EAP support new jobs and large projects that benefit the people of East Africa.

In Africa alone, more than 50 million children have been orphaned - nearly one in eight. The East Africa Partnership is dedicated to providing help and hope to these children. The Sponsorship Program, begun in 2007, allows donors to support a child for only \$25 a month. This donation provides food, shelter, medical care, and education.

The EAP currently runs or supports four different Homes throughout Kenya for orphaned children. Each child within a Home is sponsored by a donor. These orphanages reach the neediest children of all tribes and regions and are also supported by the local government. We are currently providing homes for approximately 300 orphaned children.

Each child is matched with a sponsor, who provides \$25 a month to support a child in the orphanage or allow their extended families to feed and clothe them. 100% of these funds go directly to help the child. Food and clothing are delivered by local volunteers each month, who also check the child's health and pro-

gress in school. In the Homes, every effort is made to provide a family atmosphere. The children consider each other brothers and sisters, and visitors are all aunts and uncles. Just like other children in Kenya, they do chores, helping with the farm, cooking, and cleaning in addition to their studies. The EAP has promised every child in our Homes that they will be able to continue their studies as far as their abilities and inclinations allow.
